## what is Rock the Block?

Rock the Block is a neighborhood clean-up day that includes exterior home repair and maintenance projects, such as painting and landscaping. Rock the Block calls all neighbors, homeowners and renters, to be outside together, working in the yard, and having fun. Rock the Block events serve as an extension of Habitat for Humanity's neighborhood revitalization efforts. The emphasis of this program is to help homeowners in neighborhoods where Habitat is active.

### Minor exterior home repairs (first level, reachable heights only)

- Yard clean-up, clearing brush, overgrowth & trash removal
- Pulling weeds and raking, mulching & landscaping (may include planting new flowers & bushes)
- Washing exterior windows and siding
- Gutter cleaning & minor gutter/spouting repair (first level, reachable heights only)
- Small exterior painting projects



### Commitment Levels
